King County Fire Protection District #44 requests your quotation on the public works project identified below pursuant to RCW 39.04.155. State law requires compliance with prevailing wage requirements as per WAC 296-127. All required L&I forms must be submitted before final payment is made.

General Purpose / Intent: The purpose and intent of this Request for Quotation is to solicit quotes from responsive and responsible bidders to purchase and install a 40 KW Generator for Fire Station 98.

Award: Upon acceptance by King County Fire Protection District #44, the Purchasing Department will issue a notice of award and purchase order(s) for any supplies, equipment and/or services as a result of this quote. The quote and the corresponding purchase order(s) will constitute the complete agreement between the successful respondent and King County Fire Protection District #44. Unless otherwise stipulated in the quote documents, no other contract documents shall be issued or accepted.

Subcontracting: If a vendor intends to subcontract any portion of the work for any reason, he/she must include in writing the name and address of the subcontractor, name of the person to be contacted (including telephone number) and extent of work to be performed. This information shall be submitted with the quote response. King County Fire Protection District #44 reserves the right to reject a bid of any vendor if their quote names a subcontractor who has previously failed in the proper performance of an award, or failed to deliver on time, contracts of a similar nature or who is not in a position to perform properly under this award. King County Fire Protection District #44 reserves the right to make determination as to the foregoing.

Pre Quote Inspection: An on-site pre-bid inspection to examine equipment and verify services requested will be required prior to submitting a price quotation. The dates and times of inspection will be by appointment only. Failure to make a pre-bid inspection shall not relieve the contractor from the requirement to provide services necessary, nor shall it be grounds for a change order for work that would have been apparent had a site visit been made. Vendors intending to submit a quotation shall be charged with providing a completed project without recourse to additive change order for conditions or problems that would have been apparent and included had they visited the site. Inspection appointments are to be made prior to visiting the site; the dates and times of inspection will be by appointment only.

Scope of Work:

- 1.) King County Fire Protection District #44 is requesting price quotations from licensed electrical contractors to provide services to remove the existing generator, transfer switch, and install a new 40KW generator with a new transfer switch.
- 2.) Install a concrete pad built per current building codes for the generator to be installed upon. The concrete slab shall extend out from generator 18” on all sides.
- 3.) Provide the trenching needed to install new wiring and conduit underground to the new specified location for the generator.
- 4.) Install new wiring inside the under ground conduit that is sized correctly for this generator which meets required codes.
- 5.) Install new asphalt and edge sealing to replace the asphalt removed for the trench.
- 6.) Replace concrete removed from sidewalk for trench and match texture of existing concrete sidewalk.
- 7.) Wiring shall be completed in compliance with NEC, State of Washington L&I, King County RCW’s, and any other code requirements.
- 8.) Winning bidder shall apply for and obtain all of the permits required to complete this project.

Job site inspection is required before bidding.
